Our Code of Conduct, also a Code of Kindness is to ensure that all participants in the EDCJCC After School program, including students, staff and guests, are treated with kindness and respect.

As a member of the EDCJCC Community, I will help to create a safe, fun and healthy After School environment. I understand and agree that it is my responsibility to:

- **Be an active listener, cooperate, and follow directions given by staff, supervisors, and lifeguards at all times. Cooperation and following directions are important at all times, but are particularly crucial during the walk from Ross to the EDCJCC.**
- **Treat fellow students, staff, supervisors, guests, public/private property, and the environment with the utmost respect. We expect every student to exercise goodwill towards others and towards our After School activities and facilities. Courtesy and respect are requirements of the After School community.**
- **Avoid using language that is insensitive or offensive.**
- **Resolve conflicts in a peaceful and appropriate manner. Teasing, horseplay, pushing, kicking, hitting, fighting, bullying or harassment will not be tolerated.**
- **Stay with the appropriate After School group at all times, both inside and outside the building. No student is permitted to leave the group without a staff member's permission and direct supervision.**

- Not possess cellphones or other electronics during After School Programming. Phones and other electronics must be stored in a backpack and cannot be used during After School hours unless required for a specific homework assignment (subject to the approval of EDCJCC staff). EDCJCC is not responsible for theft or damage to any student's personal property.
- Be present at and participate appropriately in all planned activities as defined by the After School schedule.
- Behave appropriately and promote a safe, fun and healthy environment through productive participation.

NOTE: It is not possible to anticipate every possible situation that may arise. In the absence of a particular situation or activity not listed above, COMMON SENSE, COURTESY AND KINDNESS SHALL PREVAIL.
